Saturday Night Pipe Carriers Dance

You do not have to carry a Pipe to Dance the Dance. This Dance is in honor of the Medicine of the Pipe and for strength for those that follow the way of the Pipe to dedicate themselves for another year. Everyone present is invited to Dance this special event. All Pipe carriers of all traditions are invited. The Dance will take place on Saturday night around a Dance Pole that has been used at eleven previous Dances. Symbolically, the Dance shows that the Pipe Carries the People and the one holding the Pipe Pledges to Pray for all the People. We Dance with filled Pipes and at the end sit quietly and Smoke. This truly is a humbling experience and the manifestation of a Vision given to Wind Daughter to carry forth as part of her Medicine.

Ceremonies are a Gift between Spirit and the Participants. There is never a charge for Ceremony. We will live & pray as a community. Each person providing his/her own food. Please bring food that can be eaten from a cooler. No coffee, tea, juice & milk will be provided each day. No private fires will be allowed, however, Coleman stoves are okay.

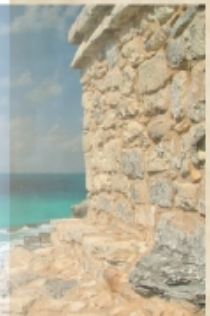
ACCOMODATIONS

Will be in a beautiful and relaxing beachfront villa. Double and triple rooms include private baths with hot water, suspended beds, private porches with hammocks as well as shaded hammock area by the beach. The cost includes lodging, daily self-service breakfast buffet (with fresh fruits, yogurt, cereal, granola, sweet breads, juice, coffee and tea), use of kitchen facilities, transportation and admission to Cenotes, and use of bicycles and snorkel gear at the Villa. Local transportation, other meals and personal expenses are extra. Participants will be responsible for arranging airplane reservations to Cancun. The program begins Thursday February 4th and runs through the evening of February 8th, 2010. You may choose to come early or stay later to avail yourself of the natural beauty and cultural opportunities in the area. A short distance away are numerous Mayan ruins, eco-archeological parks, markets with clothes and crafts, and inexpensive shops and restaurants. Upon receipt of your deposit, you will be sent more information and a list of what to bring.

You will need your valid passport.

VISIT THE ISLE OF WOMEN

Isla Mujeres - just a short ferry ride across the beautiful blue water from Cancun. In Mayan times the Island served as the sanctuary for the Goddess Ix Chel. The remains of her Temple still stands at the south point of the Island. Torch light used to filter through the holes in the walls and could be seen from miles out to sea. The Island was discovered in 1517 by the Spanish where they found Female Statues along the rocky Coastline, guarding the Island and announcing the power of the feminine.





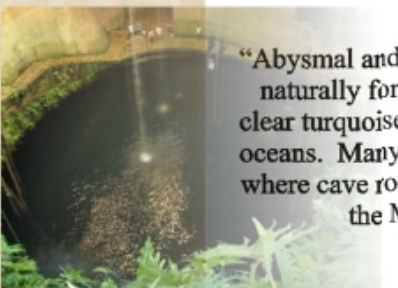
IX CHEL - AGED JAGUAR GODDESS

Of Midwifery and Medicine. She is known as Grandmother when she comes as Earth Goddess. She often appears with small jaguar ears and claws instead of feet and hands. She is the "Goddess of Making Children". As the Moon Goddess, she represents the waning Moon. She carries an inverted jar, a vessel "the womb" being emptied. As the Rain Goddess, her inverted jar represents the nourishing waters necessary for productive crops. Her 4 sons, the Jaguar gods, named for the four directions, are responsible for holding up their corners of the sky. She can take the form of Jaguar and become invisible. She is protector of Women and Children and Keeper of the souls of the dead.



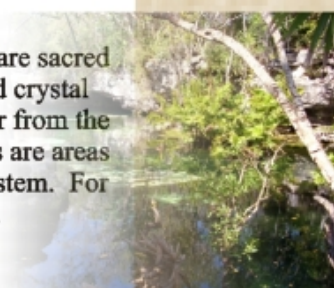
JUNGLE SPA

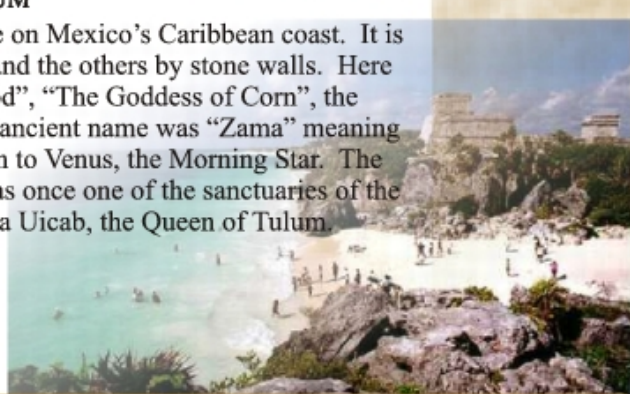
SWIM IN CENOTES

"Abysmal and Deep", Magical, Enigmatic and Unique. Cenotes are sacred naturally forming pools of water. The surface water is fresh and crystal clear turquoise color while the depths of these pools are salt water from the oceans. Many of the 1400 actually studied and registered cenotes are areas where cave roofs have collapsed revealing an underlying cave system. For the Maya they represent the entrance to the underworld.



TULUM

Is the most important archeological site on Mexico's Caribbean coast. It is protected on one side by ocean cliffs and the others by stone walls. Here we will learn about the "Diving God", "The Goddess of Corn", the "Temple of the Winds" and more. It's ancient name was "Zama" meaning Morning or Dawn, thus its connection to Venus, the Morning Star. The energy of Tulum feels feminine and was once one of the sanctuaries of the "Speaking Cross", ruled by Maria Uicab, the Queen of Tulum.
